

INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids will be received by the office of the Director-Secretary of the Board of Park Commissioners at 9160 Robinson Road, Chardon, Ohio 44024-9148 until **1:30 pm** local time on **March 5, 2019** at which time bids will be publicly opened and read for the **2019 Aggregate Stone Materials Bid**.

Plans and specifications for the project are available and can be obtained at the Geauga Park District Administrative Offices at 9160 Robinson Road, Chardon, OH 44024 or electronically by contacting the *Park Planner – Annie Lynch* at 440.279.0807 or alynch@geaugaparkdistrict.org

Bidders must obtain plans & specifications as instructed above and be on plan holders list in order to submit a qualified bid.

No bidder may withdraw his/her bid for a period of sixty (60) days after the date of bid opening. If not accepted within such period, said bid may be withdrawn.

Successful bidders shall comply with all applicable federal, state and local regulations pertaining to equal employment opportunities and be subject to the prevailing wage rates as provided for in Chapter 4115 of the Ohio Revised Code.

All bids shall be received in sealed envelopes and clearly marked with the project title, **2019 Aggregate Stone Materials Bid** and contain the full name of the bidder.

Bids not received by the Bid Submittal deadline are late. Late bids will be returned to the Bidders unopened.

The Board reserves the right to accept separate bids on various items or work, or to accept any combination of bids, in whole or in part. The Board will award the Contract based on the lowest and best bid. Geauga Park District may reject any or all bids on any basis and without disclosure of a reason or to waive any informalities or irregularities in the bids received. The failure to make such a disclosure shall not result in accrual of any right, claim, or cause of action by any unsuccessful bidder against Geauga Park District.

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
