ALL applicants must submit at least 4 images of their artwork, including one of their display booth if available. Wildlife artwork given preference over artwork depicting domestic animals.**

Application Process

Accepted exhibitors notified by mail by May 10. Payment due by June 15. No refunds for cancellations after July 1. **DO NOT SEND PAYMENT UNTIL YOU RECEIVE CONFIRMATION OF ACCEPTANCE. Mastercard or VISA only.** Applications will be accepted after April 25 as space allows.

Show Layout

A limited number of indoor spaces will be assigned at the discretion of the show committee. Show is primarily outdoors in the parking lot adjacent to the Nature Center.

\$50 - 10' x 10' outdoor tent space (no staking into pavement) **\$70** - 6' x 5' indoor space

\$80 - 8' x 5' indoor space

Limit 2 spaces per exhibitor. Table provided if requested. Electricity at most indoor spaces for an additional \$5. Electric not accessible to outdoor spaces.

Exhibitor Notes

1. Exhibitors agree to remain setup for the duration of the show.
2. All exhibitors will be responsible for collecting sales tax (6.75%) and obtaining a current Ohio Transient Vendor's License (www.tax.ohio.gov or Geauga County Auditor's Office at 440-279-1614).
3. Exhibitors must carry their own insurance to cover the value of their work and reimburse the Park District for any damage they cause.
4. Park District Rangers provide security during show hours.
5. The show committee reserves the right to require removal of items they judge to be inappropriate.
6. Exhibitors are encouraged (not required), to demonstrate in their space as appropriate.
