

## Big Creek Park's "Tree House" Camp Site E

# GUIDELINES FOR USE

Welcome to **Geauga Park District's "Tree House" Camp Site E in Big Creek Park**. This facility may be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis online at least 7 days prior to your stay *or* by phone at least 1 day prior to your stay. No walk-in camping is permitted.

Current fees (non-refundable) and camping rules can be found on our website; click Reservations and scroll down.

### **Check-in**

Cabin key can be picked up the day of arrival at Big Creek Park's Meyer Center administrative offices (open weekdays) or The West Woods Nature Center (open daily). A \$25 refundable security deposit will be required to take the key. Check-in is no earlier than 2 PM; both buildings close at 4:30 PM.

### **Check-out**

Check-out is at 12 PM (noon). Cabin should be left in a clean state prior to departure:

- Remove all trash/recycling. Receptacles are located in the campsite parking lot.
- Return tables and benches to upright and locked positions against the wall.

Upon departure, verify all doors are fully closed and locked behind you. Then drop the cabin key into the dropbox located inside the Meyer Center vestibule.

### **In order to ensure the facility is well maintained for all who use it, please observe these guidelines:**

- Open flames, cooking, small appliances, pets, tents, smoking, e-cigarette use and tobacco use are not permitted inside. Fireworks are not permitted onsite.
- Cars must be parked in the campsite parking lot.
- Fires are permitted in the fire ring only.
- Cutting shrubs or trees, bringing logs in from the woods, disturbing wildlife and defacing park property are strictly prohibited.

### **Amenities inside**

- Maximum capacity: 4 people.
- Wooden bunk bed.
- Fold-down bistro set with small table and 2 chairs.

### **Amenities outside**

- Steel fire ring with flip-up cooking grate.
- Stone bench.
- 10' x 10' tent pad.
- Restrooms are located in a separate building at the campsite parking lot. They do not have flush toilets or running water.

Please note that reservation permit holders will be held responsible for any property damage incurred.

**In the event of an emergency, call 911.** For non-emergencies or assistance, call the park office at 440-286-9516. After business hours, call Geauga County Sheriff's Office at 440-286-1234 for a ranger.
