

Geauga Park District Policies, Procedures & Guidelines for In-Person Programs

1. Participants shall not attend programs if they are feeling sick or have Covid-19 symptoms such as a cough and/or an elevated temperature.
2. Per state mandate face coverings are required for participants ages 10 and up for all indoor programs and for outdoor programs when 6 foot social distancing is not possible.
3. All staff and volunteers must also wear a face covering during each program.
4. All participants and staff shall maintain the recommended 6 foot social distancing between themselves and others as much as possible.
5. Program group sizes are limited to 10 people including Park District staff and volunteer.

Staff Responsibilities:

1. Geauga Park District staff shall contact all participants registered for programs and inform them of these policies, procedures and guidelines and supply them with a copy via email.
2. Geauga Park District staff shall have hand sanitizer available for use at all in-person programs.
3. Geauga Park District staff shall review these policies, procedures and guidelines to participants before the beginning of each program.
4. During each program, staff shall address any situations where policies, procedures and guidelines are not being observed.

Participant Responsibilities:

1. Participants shall not attend programs if they are feeling sick or have Covid-19 symptoms such as a cough and/or an elevated temperature.
2. Participants shall provide their own face covering.
3. Participants shall maintain the recommended 6 foot social distancing between others as much as possible.
4. Participants shall not bring any unregistered people with them to the program.
5. Participants shall comply with instructions from Geauga Park District staff.
