



Calling all artists living, working or attending school in Geauga County...

Geauga Park District & Geauga Arts Council invite you to participate in this exclusive project to "upcycle" galvanized steel sap buckets for the creation of artwork! One hundred buckets historically used for maple sugaring at Swine Creek Reservation will be distributed (maximum 2 per artist), and completed entries (1 or 2 per artist) will be displayed in early 2022 at The West Woods Nature Center to honor Geauga's rich maple sugaring history. Buckets may be painted/embellished in their current form or deconstructed for materials; any additional media may be utilized.

Buckets will be available for pickup at The West Woods Nature Center Mon., Nov. 15, through Sat., Nov. 20 (10 AM-4 PM) while supplies last. Artists are encouraged to submit a conceptual drawing of their project at the time of bucket pick-up. Finished projects must be delivered to the Nature Center Tues., Jan. 18, or Wed., Jan. 19 (10 AM-4 PM) and will remain on display for the duration of the exhibit. Please pick up unsold artwork Fri., April 29, or Sat., April 30 (10 AM-4 PM).

Sale of Artwork

Sale of artwork is permitted, with Geauga Park District and Geauga Arts Council each retaining 10% commission (total 20%). Checks for artwork sales will be mailed to artists within 30 days of the exhibition closing. Sold pieces must remain on display for the duration of the exhibit.
