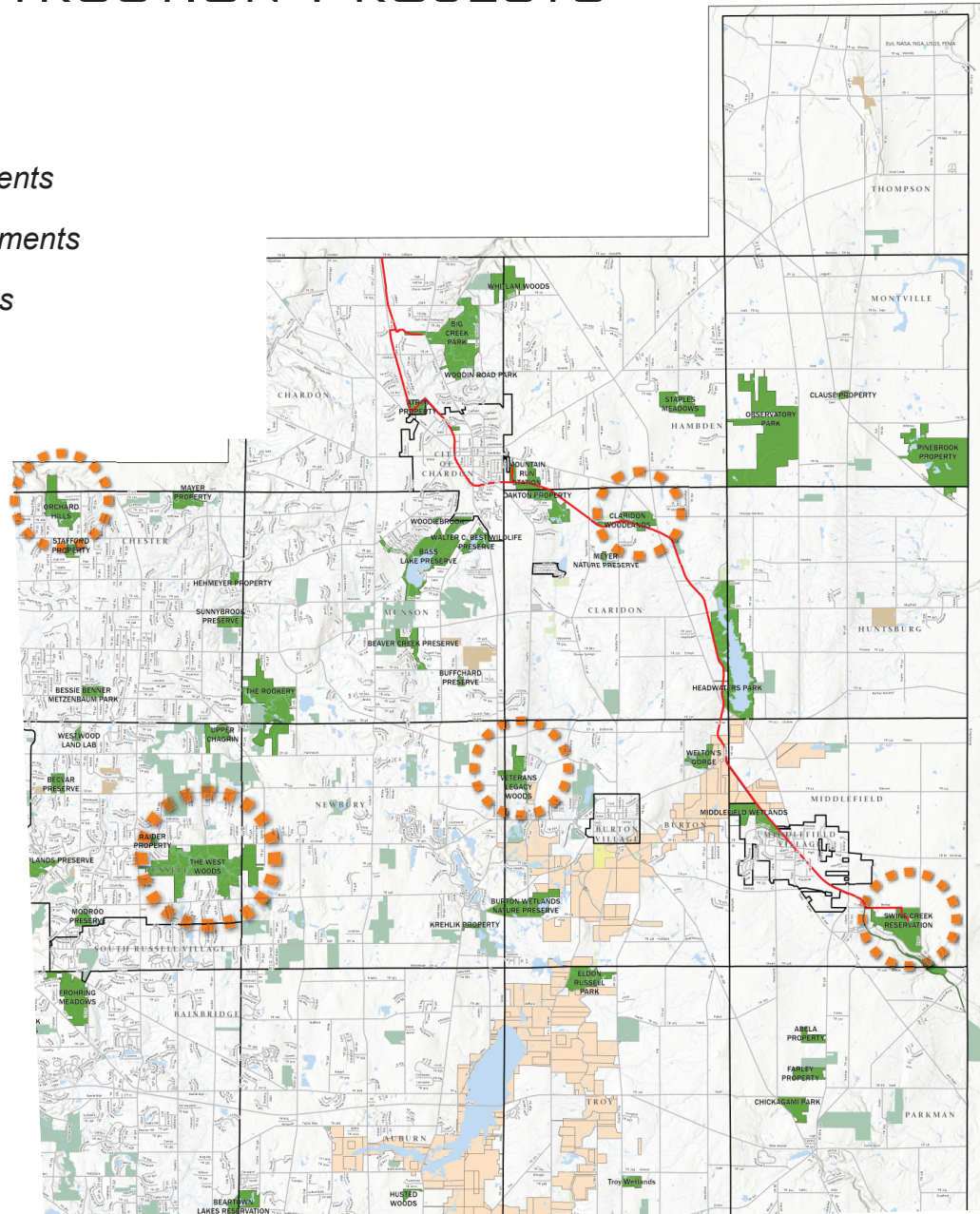
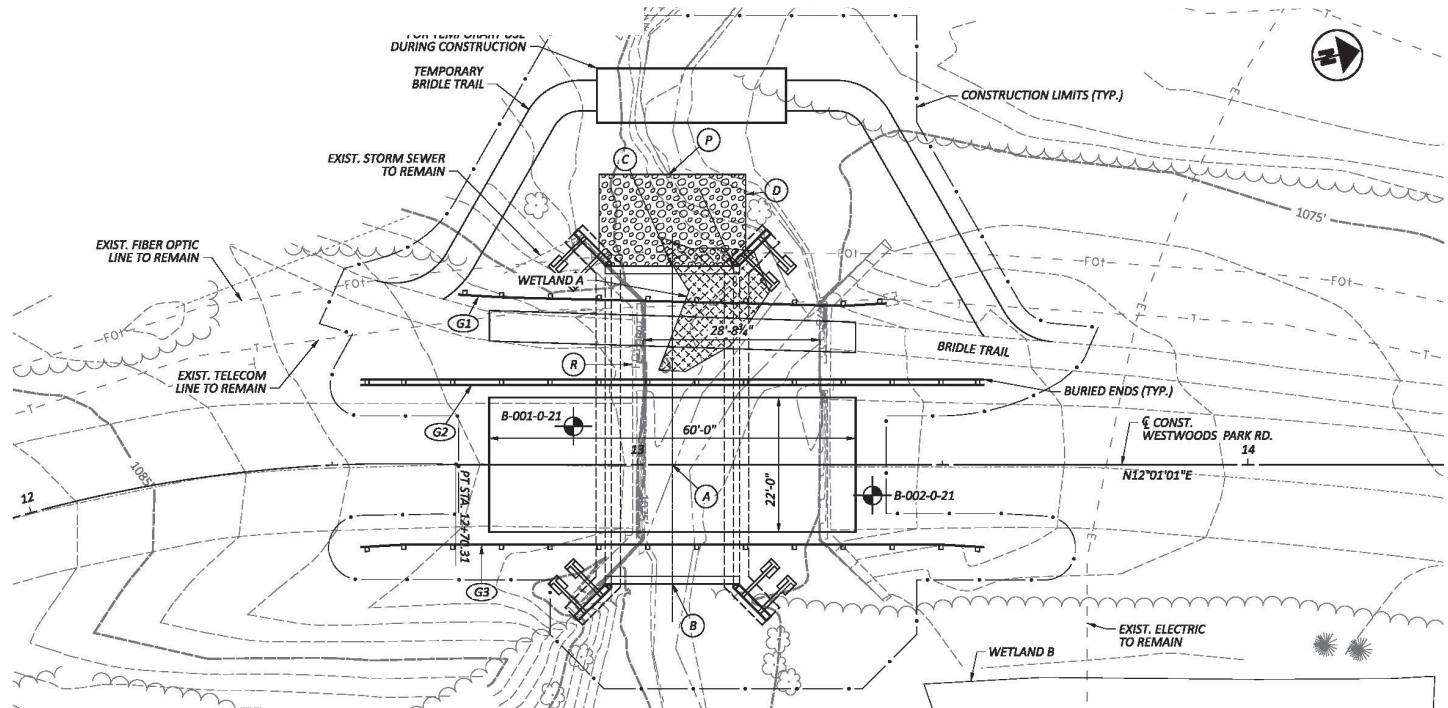
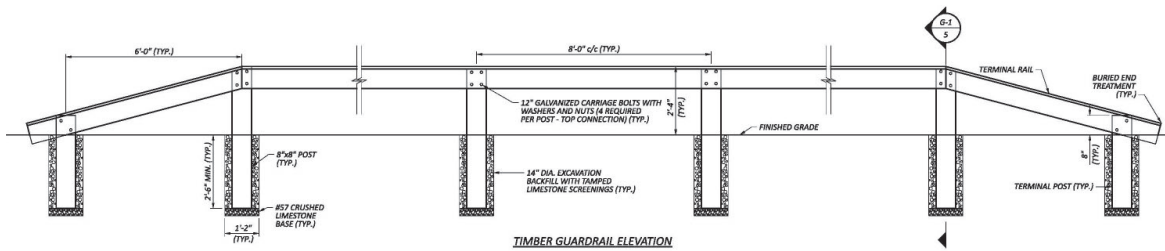

# THE WEST WOODS - ENTRY BRIDGE REPLACEMENT



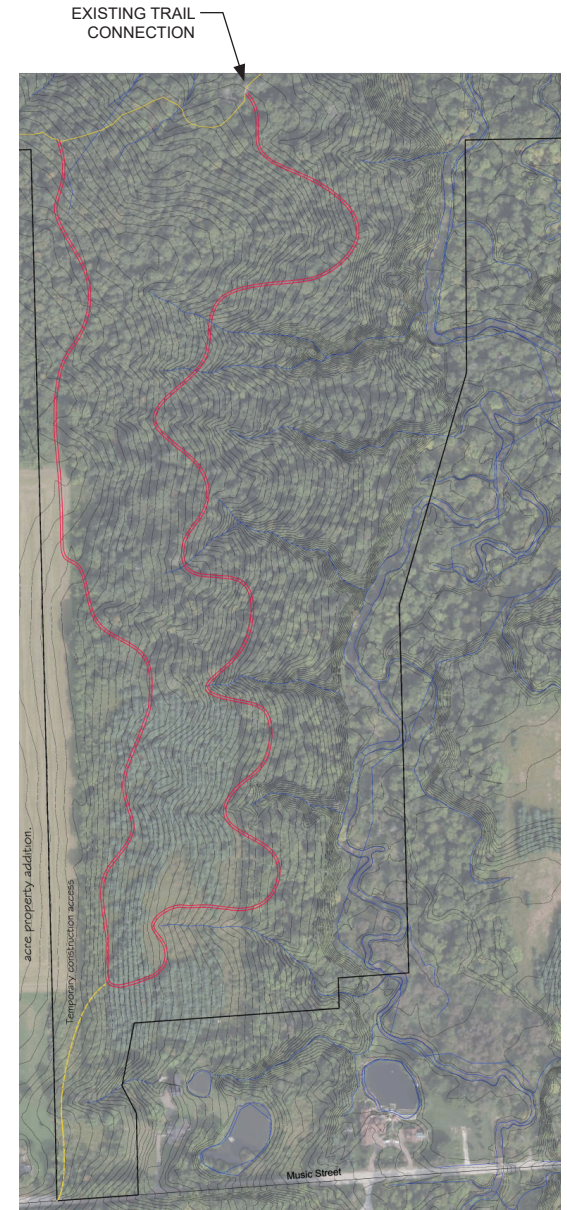
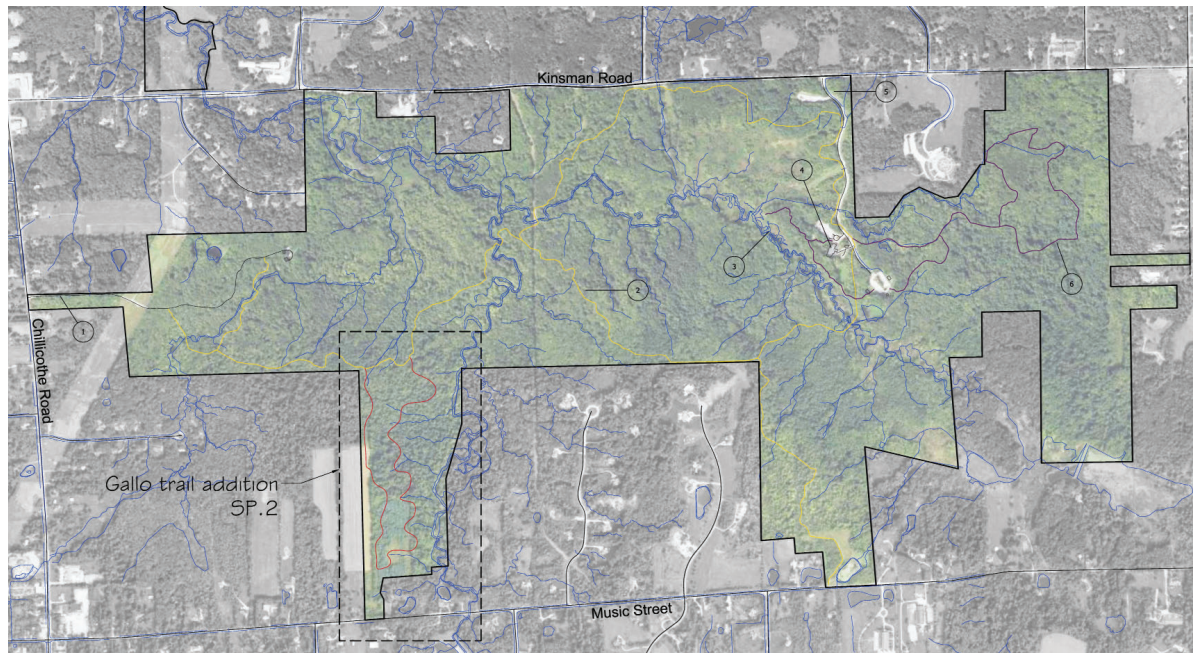
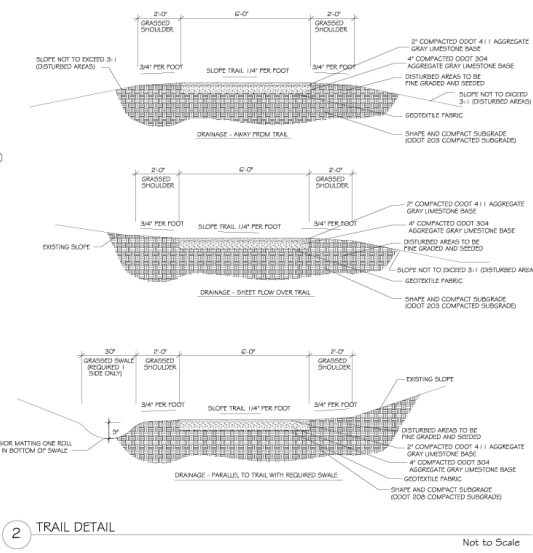
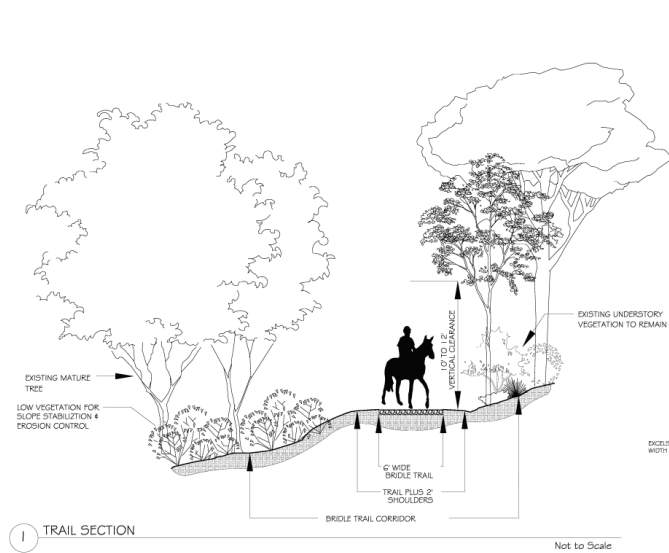
## Project Description:

The proposed trail will link to existing equestrian trails in The West Woods and add approximately 1 mile of new equestrian trail.

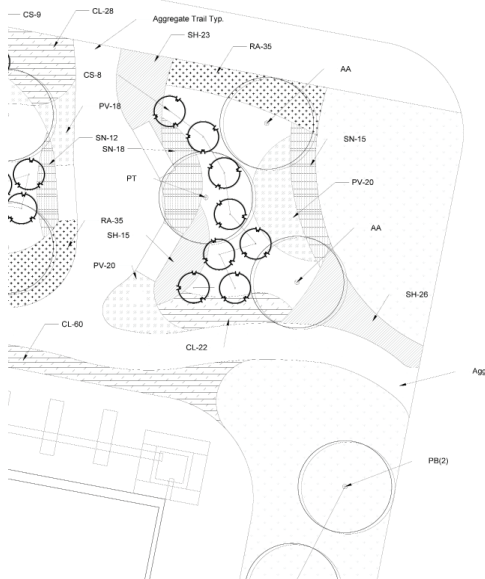

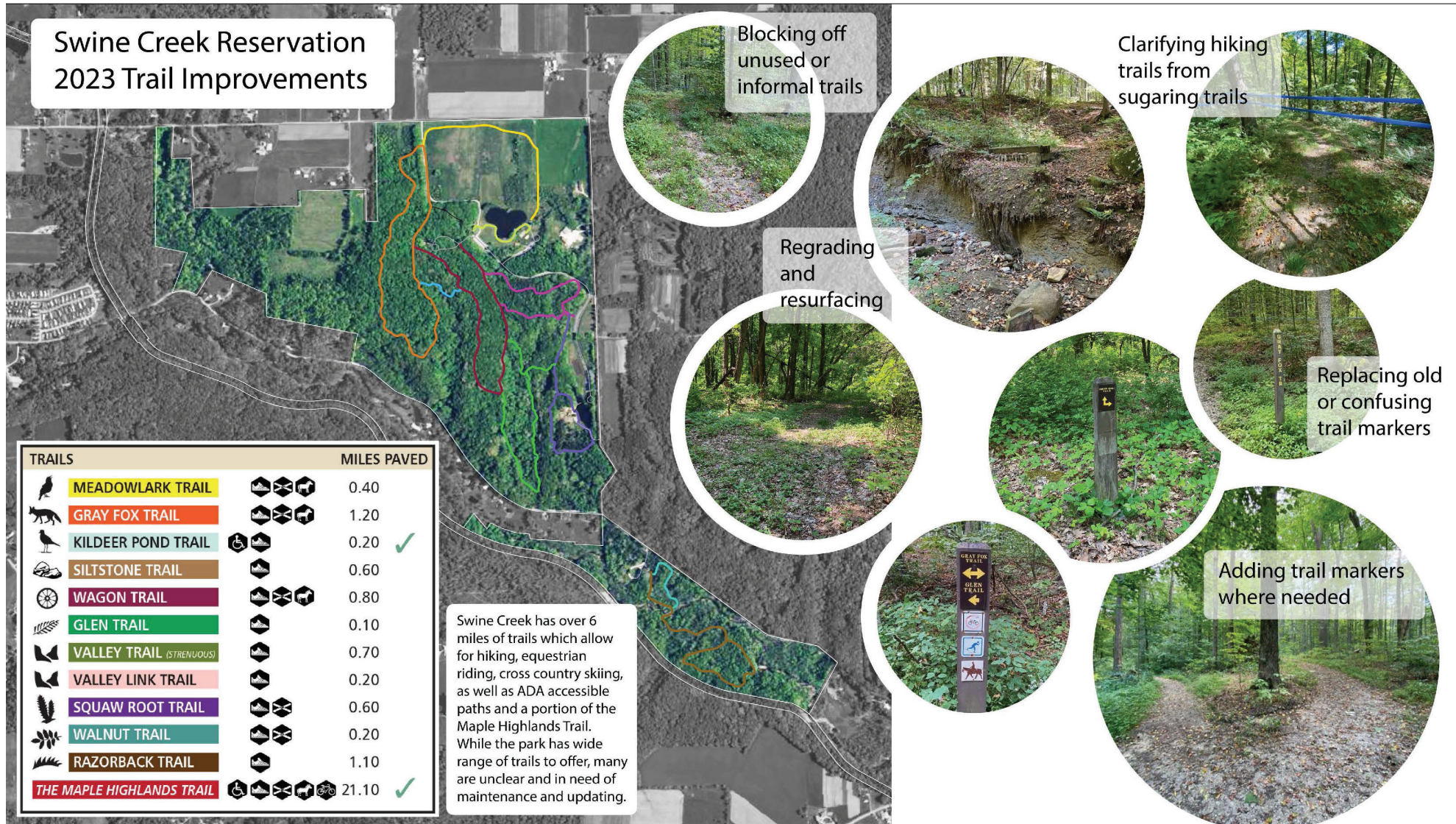
*Renovations to the plaza outside the Taylor Lodge will include native plantings and seating as well as improvements to the upper dams primary & emergency outlets*

# SWINE CREEK TRAIL & PICNIC SHELTER IMPROVEMENTS



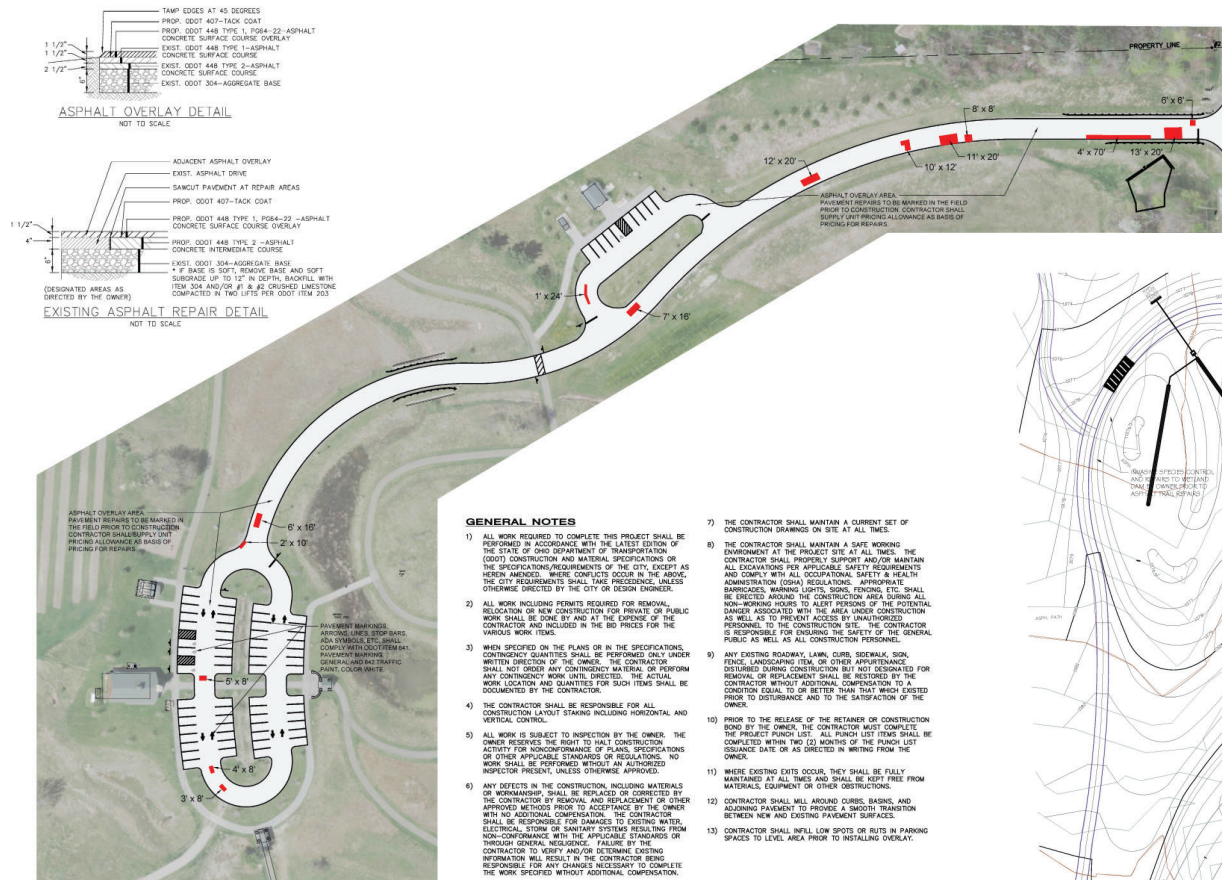
## Project Description:

# ORCHARD HILLS - ASPHALT & CRICKET TRAIL IMPROVEMENTS



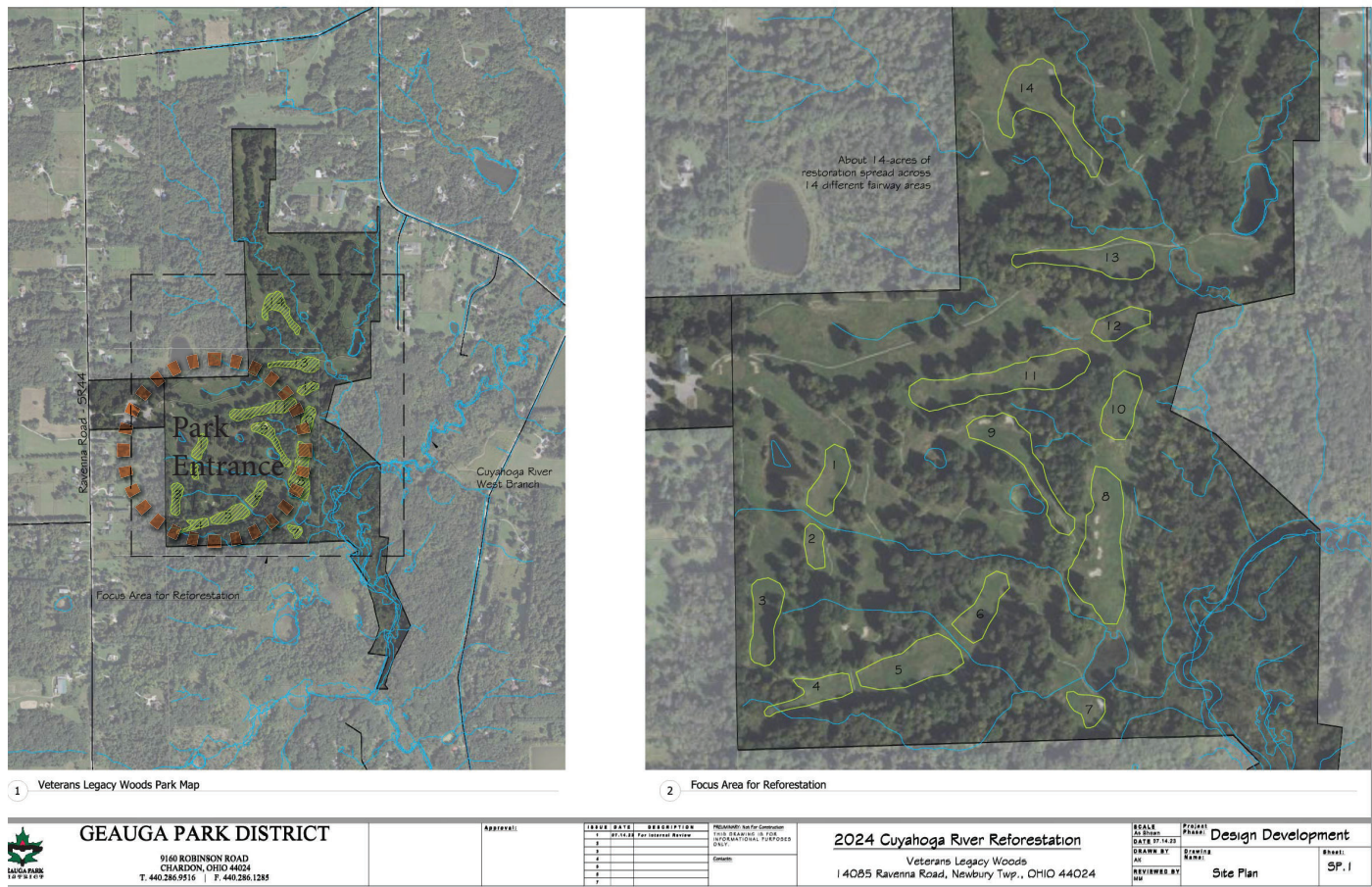
## Project Description:
